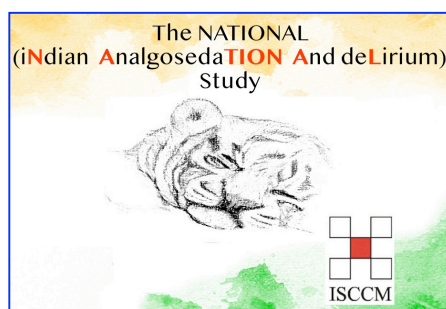


## The NATIONAL (iNdiAN AnalgosedatiON And deLirium) Study



### A Multi-center prospective study of analgosedation practices and delirium in Indian ICUs

Dear ISCCM colleagues

Thank you very much for contributing to the research conducted by the Indian Society of Critical Care Medicine. We would like to invite you to participate in yet another study endorsed by the ISCCM research committee. Please find below the brief information about the study.

The sedation and analgesia practices and the incidence of delirium, in India, remain largely unknown. Apart from a survey conducted by ISCCM in 2013, there is no nation-wide data on this important field in critical care. It is therefore difficult for the critical care practitioner in India, to decide as to how best to manage analgesia and sedation in their ICUs. We therefore decided to conduct this study. This will also inculcate the use of sedation scales and diagnosis and management of delirium in our ICUs. This study will span a period of one month, (with an additional one month, if the patient recruitment is low) after you obtain IEC approval from your institutional ethics committee.

If you are interested in participating in this study, please download the documents from the ISCCM website, in the research section tab.

All the documents required by your IEC are attached with this e-mail - Study Protocol, CRF, Approval from the IEC of coordinating center, ISCCM endorsement letter, CTRI registration document, consent forms in English, Hindi and Marathi. Please feel free to translate in any language you need to obtain consent at your centers.

If you have already obtained approval of your IEC please send it to us on the e-mail below. You can now start recruiting patients in the trial, for 30 days from the start of recruitment date.
